- 1 AN ACT Relating to motorist information signs; amending RCW
- 2 47.42.020; adding a new section to chapter 47.36 RCW; and recodifying
- 3 RCW 47.42.046, 47.42.047, 47.42.0475, 47.42.052, 47.42.160, and
- 4 47.42.170.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.42.020 and 1990 c 258 s 1 are each amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 The definitions set forth in this section apply throughout this
- 9 chapter.
- 10 (1) "Department" means the Washington state department of
- 11 transportation.
- 12 (2) "Erect" means to construct, build, raise, assemble, place,
- 13 affix, attach, create, paint, draw, or in any other way bring into
- 14 being or establish.

- 1 (3) "Interstate system" means any state highway which is or does
- 2 become part of the national system of interstate and defense highways
- 3 as described in section 103(d) of title 23, United States Code.
- 4 (4) "Maintain" means to allow to exist.
- 5 (5) "Person" means this state or any public or private corporation,
- 6 firm, partnership, association, as well as any individual or
- 7 individuals.
- 8 (6) "Primary system" means any state highway which is or does
- 9 become part of the federal-aid primary system as described in section
- 10 103(b) of title 23, United States Code.
- 11 (7) "Scenic system" means (a) any state highway within any public
- 12 park, federal forest area, public beach, public recreation area, or
- 13 national monument, (b) any state highway or portion thereof outside the
- 14 boundaries of any incorporated city or town designated by the
- 15 legislature as a part of the scenic system, or (c) any state highway or
- 16 portion thereof outside the boundaries of any incorporated city or town
- 17 designated by the legislature as a part of the scenic and recreational
- 18 highway system except for the sections of highways specifically
- 19 excluded in RCW 47.42.025.
- 20 (8) "Sign" means any outdoor sign, display, device, figure,
- 21 painting, drawing, message, placard, poster, billboard, or other thing
- 22 that is designed, intended, or used to advertise or inform, any part of
- 23 the advertising or informative contents of which is visible from any
- 24 place on the main-traveled way of the interstate system or other state
- 25 highway.
- 26 (9) "Commercial and industrial areas" means any area zoned
- 27 commercial or industrial by a county or municipal code, or if unzoned
- 28 by a county or municipal code, that area occupied by three or more
- 29 separate and distinct commercial or industrial activities, or any
- 30 combination thereof, within a space of five hundred feet and the area

- 1 within five hundred feet of such activities on both sides of the
- 2 highway. The area shall be measured from the outer edges of the
- 3 regularly used buildings, parking lots, or storage or processing areas
- 4 of the commercial or industrial activity and not from the property
- 5 lines of the parcels upon which the activities are located.
- 6 Measurements shall be along or parallel to the edge of the main
- 7 traveled way of the highway. The following shall not be considered
- 8 commercial or industrial activities:
- 9 (a) Agricultural, forestry, grazing, farming, and related
- 10 activities, including, but not limited to, wayside fresh produce
- 11 stands;
- 12 (b) Transient or temporary activities;
- (c) Railroad tracks and minor sidings;
- 14 (d) Signs;
- 15 (e) Activities more than six hundred and sixty feet from the
- 16 nearest edge of the right of way;
- 17 (f) Activities conducted in a building principally used as a
- 18 residence.
- 19 If any commercial or industrial activity that has been used in defining
- 20 or delineating an unzoned area ceases to operate for a period of six
- 21 continuous months, any signs located within the former unzoned area
- 22 become nonconforming and shall not be maintained by any person.
- 23 (10) (("Specific information panel" means a panel, rectangular in
- 24 shape, located in the same manner as other official traffic signs
- 25 readable from the main traveled ways, and consisting of:
- 26 (a) The words "GAS," "FOOD," or "LODGING" and directional
- 27 information; and
- 28 (b) One or more individual business signs mounted on the panel.
- 29 (11) "Business sign" means a separately attached sign mounted on
- 30 the specific information panel or roadside area information panel to

- 1 show the brand or trademark and name, or both, of the motorist service
- 2 available on the crossroad at or near the interchange. Nationally,
- 3 regionally, or locally known commercial symbols or trademarks for
- 4 service stations, restaurants, and motels shall be used when
- 5 applicable. The brand or trademark identification symbol used on the
- 6 business sign shall be reproduced with the colors and general shape
- 7 consistent with customary use. Any messages, trademarks, or brand
- 8 symbols which interfere with, imitate, or resemble any official warning
- 9 or regulatory traffic sign, signal, or device are prohibited.
- (12)) "Roadside area information panel or display" means a panel
- 11 or display located so as not to be readable from the main traveled way,
- 12 erected in a safety rest area, scenic overlook, or similar roadside
- 13 area, for providing motorists with information in the specific interest
- 14 of the traveling public.
- 15 ((<del>(13)</del> "Tourist-oriented directional sign" means a sign on a
- 16 specific information panel on the state highway system to provide
- 17 directional information to a qualified tourist-oriented business,
- 18 service, or activity.
- 19 (14) "Qualified tourist-oriented business" means any lawful
- 20 cultural, historical, recreational, educational, or entertaining
- 21 activity or a unique or unusual commercial or nonprofit activity, the
- 22 major portion of whose income or visitors are derived during its normal
- 23 business season from motorists not residing in the immediate area of
- 24 the activity.
- 25 (15))) (11) "Temporary agricultural directional sign" means a sign
- 26 on private property adjacent to state highway right of way to provide
- 27 directional information to places of business offering for sale
- 28 seasonal agricultural products on the property where the sale is taking
- 29 place.

- 1  $((\frac{16}{10}))$  (12) "Adopt-a-highway sign" means a sign on state highway
- 2 right of way referring to the department's adopt-a-highway litter
- 3 control program.

- 8 (1) "Erect" means to construct, build, raise, assemble, place,

- 25 recreational highway system except for the sections of highways
- 26 specifically excluded in RCW 47.42.025.
- 27 (6) "Specific information panel" means a panel, rectangular in
- 28 shape, located in the same manner as other official traffic signs
- 29 readable from the main traveled ways, and consisting of:

- 1 (a) The words "GAS," "FOOD," or "LODGING" and directional
- 2 information; and
- 3 (b) One or more individual business signs mounted on the panel.
- 4 (7) "Business sign" means a separately attached sign mounted on the
- 5 specific information panel or roadside area information panel to show
- 6 the brand or trademark and name, or both, of the motorist service
- 7 available on the crossroad at or near the interchange. Nationally,
- 8 regionally, or locally known commercial symbols or trademarks for
- 9 service stations, restaurants, and motels shall be used when
- 10 applicable. The brand or trademark identification symbol used on the
- 11 business sign shall be reproduced with the colors and general shape
- 12 consistent with customary use. Messages, trademarks, or brand symbols
- 13 that interfere with, imitate, or resemble an official warning or
- 14 regulatory traffic sign, signal, or device are prohibited.
- 15 (8) "Roadside area information panel or display" means a panel or
- 16 display located so as not to be readable from the main traveled way,
- 17 erected in a safety rest area, scenic overlook, or similar roadside
- 18 area, for providing motorists with information in the specific interest
- 19 of the traveling public.
- 20 (9) "Tourist-oriented directional sign" means a sign on a specific
- 21 information panel on the state highway system to provide directional
- 22 information to a qualified tourist-oriented business, service, or
- 23 activity.
- 24 (10) "Qualified tourist-oriented business" means a lawful cultural,
- 25 historical, recreational, educational, or entertaining activity or a
- 26 unique or unusual commercial or nonprofit activity, the major portion
- 27 of whose income or visitors are derived during its normal business
- 28 season from motorists not residing in the immediate area of the
- 29 activity.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** RCW 47.42.046, 47.42.047, 47.42.0475,
- 2 47.42.052, 47.42.160, and 47.42.170 are each recodified as sections in
- 3 chapter 47.36 RCW. The code reviser may correct internal references
- 4 within the recodified sections accordingly.
