- 1 AN ACT Relating to the sale and resale of admission tickets; adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 9.91 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.91 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) For the purposes of this section, "commercial ticket reseller"
- 7 means a person or entity who in the normal course of business purchases
- 8 admission tickets from individuals or official ticket sales outlets at
- 9 the box office price for the purpose of reselling the tickets to
- 10 individuals at a price higher than the box office price. The
- 11 advertised price must include all handling, service, convenience, or
- 12 other charges that must be paid by the purchaser to obtain the ticket.
- 13 (2) It is unlawful:

1 (a) To fail to refund, within thirty days of a written request, the

advertised price of an admission ticket or card, for any cancelled

- 4 (b) For a commercial ticket reseller to fail to include the price
- 5 or range of prices of tickets or cards available to an event in any
- 6 print advertisement of the event. For purposes of this section,
- 7 tickets or cards available at the event itself, for which no handling,
- 8 service, convenience, or other charges must be paid, shall not be
- 9 included in the range of ticket prices; or
- 10 (c) For a commercial ticket reseller to sell an admission ticket or
- 11 card on which the name of the person conducting the event and the price
- 12 are not conspicuously and indelibly printed, stamped, or written, or to
- 13 sell or offer to sell an admission ticket or card at a price in excess
- 14 of the advertised price.
- 15 (3) The sale and resale of admission tickets or cards is a matter
- 16 affecting the public interest for the purpose of applying chapter 19.86
- 17 RCW. A violation of this section is not reasonable in relation to the
- 18 to the development and preservation of business. A violation of this
- 19 section constitutes an unfair or deceptive act or practice in trade or
- 20 commerce for the purpose of applying chapter 19.86 RCW.
- 21 (4) A violation of this section is a misdemeanor.
