- 1 AN ACT Relating to clarifying existing crop lien coverage and
- 2 filing procedures; and amending RCW 60.11.030 and 60.11.050.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 60.11.030 and 1986 c 242 s 3 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Upon filing, the liens described in RCW 60.11.020 shall attach to
- 7 the crop for all sums then <u>due</u> and <u>which may</u> thereafter ((due)) <u>arise</u>
- 8 and become owing the lien holder and shall continue in all identifiable
- 9 cash proceeds of the crop.
- 10 **Sec. 2.** RCW 60.11.050 and 1986 c 242 s 5 are each amended to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 (1) Except as provided in subsections (2), (3), and (4) of this
- 13 section, conflicting liens and security interests shall rank in
- 14 accordance with the time of filing.

- 1 (2) The lien created in RCW 60.11.020(2) in favor of any person who
- 2 furnishes any work or labor upon the land of the grower or landowner
- 3 shall be preferred and prior to any other lien or security interest
- 4 upon the crops to which they attach including the liens described in
- 5 subsections (3) and (4) of this section.
- 6 (3) A lien or security interest in crops otherwise entitled to
- 7 priority pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall be
- 8 subordinate to a later filed lien or security interest to the extent
- 9 that obligations secured by such earlier filed security interest or
- 10 lien were not incurred to produce such crops.
- 11 (4) A lien or security interest in crops otherwise entitled to
- 12 priority pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall be
- 13 subordinate to a ((properly filed)) landlord's lien that has been filed
- 14 prior to the filing of the lien or security interest or before the
- 15 completion of the harvest of the crops for which the lien is claimed.
- 16 A landlord's lien shall retain its priority if refiled within six
- 17 months prior to its expiration.
