- 1 AN ACT Relating to authorized combinations of vehicles; and
- 2 amending RCW 46.44.037.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 46.44.037 and 1991 c 143 s 2 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 46.44.036 and subject to such
- 7 rules and regulations governing their operation as may be adopted by
- 8 the state department of transportation, operation of the following
- 9 combinations is lawful:
- 10 (1) A combination consisting of a truck tractor, a semitrailer, and
- 11 another semitrailer or a full trailer. In this combination a converter
- 12 gear used to convert a semitrailer into a full trailer shall be
- 13 considered to be a part of the full trailer and not a separate vehicle.

- 1 A converter gear being pulled without load and not used to convert a
- 2 semitrailer into a full trailer may be substituted in lieu of a full
- 3 trailer or a semitrailer in any lawful combination;
- 4 (2) A combination not exceeding seventy-five feet in overall length
- 5 consisting of four trucks or truck tractors used in driveaway service
- 6 where three of the vehicles are towed by the fourth in triple
- 7 saddlemount position;
- 8 (3) A combination consisting of a truck tractor carrying a freight
- 9 compartment no longer than eight feet, a semitrailer, and another
- 10 semitrailer or full trailer that meets the legal length requirement for
- 11 a truck and trailer combination set forth in RCW 46.44.030.
- 12 (4) A combination consisting of a motor vehicle weighing more than
- 13 four thousand pounds unladen, a travel trailer not exceeding twenty-two
- 14 feet in length, and a trailer designed for hauling a boat with a gross
- 15 weight of one thousand pounds. The vehicles in combination shall not
- 16 exceed sixty-five feet in length and must have a braking capacity in
- 17 excess of the gross weight of the combination. The trailers must be
- 18 connected by hitches designed and attached in such a manner to be
- 19 capable of towing the gross weight of the trailer(s) in tow.
