- 1 AN ACT Relating to membership of pension boards under chapter 41.18
- 2 RCW; and amending RCW 41.18.015.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 41.18.015 and 1961 c 255 s 11 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 There is hereby created in each fire protection district which
- 7 qualifies under this chapter, a firemen's pension board to consist of
- 8 the following five members, the chairman of the fire commissioners for
- 9 said district who shall be chairman of the board, the county auditor,
- 10 county treasurer, and in addition, two regularly employed ((firemen))
- 11 or retired fire fighters elected by secret ballot of the ((firemen))
- 12 employed and retired fire fighters. Retired members who are subject to
- 13 the jurisdiction of the pension board have both the right to elect and
- 14 the right to be elected under this section. The first members to be

elected by the ((firemen)) fire fighters shall be ((for a term of one 1 2 and two years, respectively, and their successors shall be)) elected 3 annually for a two\_year term. ((<del>That</del>)) <u>T</u>he two ((<del>firemen so</del>)) <u>fire</u> 4 fighter elected members shall, in turn, select a third ((fireman)) eligible member who shall serve in the event of an absence of one of 5 6 the regularly elected ((firemen)) members. In case a vacancy occurs in 7 the membership of the ((firemen)) fire fighter or retired members, the members ((of the fire department)) shall in the same manner elect a 8 9 successor to serve ((his)) the unexpired term. The board may select 10 and appoint a secretary who may, but need not be a member of the board. In case of absence or inability of the chairman to act, the board may 11 12 select a chairman pro tempore who shall during such absence or 13 inability perform the duties and exercise the powers of the chairman. 14 A majority of the members of said board shall constitute a quorum and have power to transact business. 15
