- 1 AN ACT Relating to commercial salmon licenses; amending RCW
- 2 75.28.035 and 75.28.040; adding new sections to Title 75 RCW; and
- 3 providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 75.28.035 and 1989 c 316 s 1 are each amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 An application for issuance or renewal of a commercial fishing
- 8 license shall contain the name and address of the vessel owner, the
- 9 name and address of the vessel operator, the name and number of the
- 10 vessel, a description of the vessel and fishing gear to be carried on
- 11 the vessel, and other information required by the department.
- 12 At the time of issuance of a commercial fishing license the
- 13 director shall furnish the licensee with a vessel registration and two
- 14 license decals.

- 1 Vessel registrations and license decals issued by the director
- 2 shall be displayed as provided by rule of the director.
- 3 A commercial fishing license is not valid if the vessel is operated
- 4 by a person other than the operator listed on the license. ((The
- 5 director may authorize additional operators for the license. Unless
- 6 adjusted by the director pursuant to the director's authority granted
- 7 in RCW 75.28.065, the fee for an additional operator is twenty dollars.
- 8 The vessel owner shall notify the director on forms provided by the
- 9 department of changes of ownership or operator and a new license shall
- 10 be issued upon payment of a fee of twenty dollars.))
- 11 A defaced, mutilated, or lost license or license decal shall be
- 12 replaced immediately. Unless adjusted by the director pursuant to the
- 13 director's authority granted in RCW 75.28.065, the replacement fee is
- 14 ten dollars.
- 15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 75.28.040 and 1983 1st ex.s. c 46 s 108 are each
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Commercial licenses and permits expire at midnight on December 31st
- 18 following their issuance and in accordance with this title may be
- 19 renewed annually upon application and payment of the prescribed license
- 20 fees and meeting the one thousand pound salmon landing requirement for
- 21 <u>salmon licenses</u>.
- 22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** In order to renew a commercial salmon
- 23 fishing license a licensee must have landed one thousand pounds of
- 24 salmon in a Washington state fishery in the immediately previous
- 25 calendar year. Department fish tickets shall be required documentation
- 26 for this requirement.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Commercial salmon licenses may be
- 2 transferred to other persons only if the transferee is a spouse or
- 3 child of the transferor and the transferee has landed one thousand
- 4 pounds of salmon in a Washington state fishery the previous calendar
- 5 year.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Commercial salmon licensees are the only
- 7 persons who may fish with a commercial fishing vessel in a commercial
- 8 salmon fishery. Additional operators are not authorized.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A person may not be licensed with more
- 10 than one commercial salmon fishing license at a time.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** The director shall issue a maximum of
- 12 one hundred eighty charter boat salmon licenses. The director shall
- 13 establish a lottery selection process for calendar year 1993 charter
- 14 boat salmon licenses. Only valid 1992 salmon charter boat licenses
- 15 shall be eligible for inclusion in the lottery selection. No salmon
- 16 landing requirement is required in order to renew salmon charter boat
- 17 licenses.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** Sections 3 through 7 of this act are
- 19 each added to Title 75 RCW.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **Sec. 9**. If any provision of this act or its
- 21 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 22 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 23 persons or circumstances is not affected.

- 1 NEW SECTION. Sec. 10. This act shall take effect January 1,
- 2 1993.
