1 AN ACT Relating to fire inspections required for the issuance of
2 business operation permits and licenses; and adding a new section to
3 chapter 48.48 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.48 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 The director of community development, through the director of fire
8 protection, or his or her authorized deputy, shall assure that no
9 delays occur in the conduct of inspections required for the issuance of
10 business operation permits and licenses. If necessary, the director of
11 community development, through the director of fire protection, or his
12 or her authorized deputy, shall promptly delegate such inspection and
13 approval authority to local fire protection personnel. Such necessity
14 may include, but not be limited to, situations in which: (1) The

1 regularly assigned and authorized employee has been terminated, has
2 resigned or retired, or due to illness or other cause is unable to
3 promptly complete required inspections; or (2) the volume of required
4 inspections has increased to the point where the regularly assigned and
5 authorized employee cannot promptly complete the work.
