1 AN ACT Relating to criminal impersonation of a law enforcement
2 officer; amending RCW 9A.60.040; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.60.040 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.60.040 are
5 each amended to read as follows:

6 (1) A person is guilty of criminal impersonation if ((he)) the
7 person:

8 (a) Assumes a false identity and does an act in ((his)) that
9 assumed character with intent to defraud another or for any other
10 unlawful purpose; ((or))

11 (b) Pretends to be a representative of some person or organization
12 or a public servant and does an act in ((his)) that pretended capacity
13 with intent to defraud another or for any other unlawful purpose; or

1 (c) Pretends to be a law enforcement officer and does an act in
2 that pretended capacity with intent to harass, intimidate, restrain,
3 torment, or embarrass another person.

4 (2) Criminal impersonation is a gross misdemeanor.
