- AN ACT Relating to historic preservation; amending RCW 27.34.020;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 27.34 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** It is the intent of the legislature that
- 5 historic motion picture theaters remain in operation as motion picture
- 6 theaters whenever possible. The policy of the state of Washington is
- 7 that agreements that prevent operations for more than a year are not
- 8 favored and operate to unreasonably restrain trade.
- 9 **Sec. 2.** RCW 27.34.020 and 1986 c 266 s 9 are each amended to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in
- 12 this section apply throughout this chapter:

- 1 (1) "Advisory council" means the advisory council on historic
- 2 preservation.
- 3 (2) "Department" means the department of community development.
- 4 (3) "Director" means the director of community development.
- 5 (4) "Federal act" means the national historic preservation act of
- 6 1966 (Public Law 89-655; 80 Stat. 915).
- 7 (5) "Heritage council" means the Washington state heritage council.
- 8 (6) "Historic motion picture theater" means a theater that has been
- 9 <u>listed in a community register of historic places or in the national</u>
- 10 register of historic places and was constructed primarily for the
- 11 <u>exhibition of motion picture film.</u>
- 12 (7) "Historic preservation" includes the protection,
- 13 rehabilitation, restoration, identification, scientific excavation, and
- 14 reconstruction of districts, sites, buildings, structures, and objects
- 15 significant in American and Washington state history, architecture,
- 16 archaeology, or culture.
- 17 $((\frac{7}{1}))$ (8) "Office" means the office of archaeology and historic
- 18 preservation within the department of community development.
- 19 $((\frac{8}{1}))$ (9) "Preservation officer" means the state historic
- 20 preservation officer as provided for in RCW 27.34.210.
- 21 $((\frac{9}{}))$ (10) "Project" means programs leading to the preservation
- 22 for public benefit of historical properties, whether by state and local
- 23 governments or other public bodies, or private organizations or
- 24 individuals, including the acquisition of title or interests in, and
- 25 the development of, any district, site, building, structure, or object
- 26 that is significant in American and Washington state history,
- 27 architecture, archaeology, or culture, and property used in connection
- 28 therewith, or for its development.

- 1 $((\frac{10}{10}))$ "State historical agencies" means the state
- 2 historical societies and the office of archaeology and historic
- 3 preservation within the department of community development.
- 4 $((\frac{11}{1}))$ <u>(12)</u> "State historical societies" means the Washington
- 5 state historical society, the eastern Washington state historical
- 6 society, and the state capital historical association.
- 7 $((\frac{12}{12}))$ "Cultural resource management plan" means a
- 8 comprehensive plan which identifies and organizes information on the
- 9 state of Washington's historic, archaeological, and architectural
- 10 resources into a set of management criteria, and which is to be used
- 11 for producing reliable decisions, recommendations, and advice relative
- 12 to the identification, evaluation, and protection of these resources.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 27.34 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- No conveyance of a historic motion picture theater may contain a
- 16 term or condition that prohibits the primary use of the theater for
- 17 more than one year from the date of the conveyance.
