- 1 AN ACT Relating to salmon guide licenses; amending RCW 75.28.010
- 2 and 75.28.710; and adding a new section to chapter 75.28 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 75.28.010 and 1991 c 362 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Except as otherwise provided by this title, a license or permit
- 7 issued by the director is required to:
- 8 (a) Commercially fish for or take food fish or shellfish;
- 9 (b) Deliver food fish or shellfish taken in offshore waters;
- 10 (c) Operate a charter boat;
- (d) Engage in processing or wholesaling food fish or shellfish;
- 12 ((or))

- 1 (e) Operate as a guide for salmon for personal use in freshwater
- 2 rivers and streams, other than that part of the Columbia river below
- 3 the bridge at Longview; or
- 4 (f) Operate a vessel for the purposes of (e) of this subsection.
- 5 (2) It is unlawful to engage in the activities described in
- 6 subsection (1) of this section without having in possession the
- 7 licenses or permits required by this title.
- 8 (3) No license or permit is required for the production or
- 9 harvesting of private sector cultured aquatic products as defined in
- 10 RCW 15.85.020 or for the delivery, processing, or wholesaling of such
- 11 aquatic products. However, if a means of identifying such products is
- 12 required by rules adopted under RCW 15.85.060, the exemption from
- 13 licensing or permit requirements established by this subsection applies
- 14 only if the aquatic products are identified in conformance with those
- 15 rules.
- 16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 75.28.710 and 1991 c 362 s 2 are each amended to read
- 17 as follows:
- 18 A professional salmon guide license is required for the holder to
- 19 offer or perform the services of a professional salmon guide in the
- 20 taking of salmon for personal use in freshwater rivers and streams,
- 21 other than in that part of the Columbia river below the bridge at
- 22 Longview. A professional salmon guide license entitles the holder to
- 23 guide for salmon from the shore or from a vessel licensed in the state
- 24 of Washington or in another state.
- 25 The annual license fees are fifty dollars for residents and five
- 26 hundred dollars for nonresidents. A surcharge of twenty dollars shall
- 27 be assessed on each resident guide license and a surcharge of one
- 28 hundred dollars shall be assessed on each nonresident guide license for
- 29 the purposes of RCW 75.50.100.

- 1 The department shall issue professional salmon guide licenses to
- 2 <u>natural persons and not to vessels. As used in this section, "holder"</u>
- 3 means a natural person and not a vessel.
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 75.28 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 A salmon guide vessel operator license is required for a person to
- 7 operate a vessel for a salmon guide. A salmon guide vessel operator
- 8 license entitles the holder to operate a vessel used by a licensed
- 9 salmon guide. The annual license fee is twenty dollars for the salmon
- 10 guide vessel operator license.
