- AN ACT Relating to recreational diving; amending RCW 75.25.005,
- 2 75.25.090, and 75.25.190; adding a new section to chapter 75.25 RCW;
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 75.08 RCW; and adding a new section to
- 4 chapter 75.12 RCW.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 75.25 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) A recreational diving license is required for all persons to
- 9 take food fish by diving, or possess food fish taken by diving, for
- 10 personal use from state waters.
- 11 (2) The annual fees for recreational diving licenses are:
- 12 (a) For a resident, six dollars; and
- 13 (b) For a nonresident, eighteen dollars.

- 1 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 75.08 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 Taking food fish while diving with either scuba or skin diving gear
- 4 is prohibited in Hood Canal waters for a period of five years following
- 5 the effective date of this act.
- 6 Prior to reopening Hood Canal waters for the taking of food fish
- 7 with diving gear, the department shall make an assessment of the
- 8 population of lingcod, rockfish, and cabezon in Hood Canal, to
- 9 determine if sufficient recovery of these fish stocks has occurred to
- 10 justify reopening the diving season.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 75.12 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 (1) It is unlawful to take salmon with skin or scuba diving gear.
- 14 (2) It is unlawful to possess salmon taken with skin or scuba
- 15 diving gear.
- 16 **Sec. 4.** RCW 75.25.005 and 1989 c 305 s 1 are each amended to read
- 17 as follows:
- 18 The following recreational fishing licenses are administered and
- 19 issued by the department of fisheries under authority of the director
- 20 of fisheries:
- 21 (1) Hood Canal shrimp license;
- 22 (2) Razor clam license;
- 23 (3) Personal use fishing license;
- 24 (4) Salmon license; ((and))
- 25 (5) Sturgeon license; and
- 26 (6) Recreational diving license.

- 1 **Sec. 5.** RCW 75.25.090 and 1989 c 305 s 5 are each amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 (1) A personal use license is required for all persons other than
- 4 persons under fifteen years of age to fish for, take, or possess food
- 5 fish for personal use from state waters or offshore waters. A personal
- 6 use license is not required under this section to (a) fish for, take,
- 7 or possess carp and sturgeon in the Columbia river above Chief Joseph
- 8 Dam, smelt, or albacore or (b) take food fish by diving or possess food
- 9 fish taken by diving.
- 10 (2) The fees for annual personal use licenses are:
- 11 (a) For a resident fifteen years of age or older and under seventy
- 12 years of age, three dollars; and
- 13 (b) For a nonresident fifteen years of age or older, ten dollars.
- 14 (3) The fees for two-consecutive-day personal use licenses are:
- 15 (a) For food fish other than sturgeon, three dollars; and
- 16 (b) For sturgeon only, three dollars.
- 17 **Sec. 6.** RCW 75.25.190 and 1989 c 305 s 10 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:
- 19 Catch record cards necessary for proper management of the state's
- 20 food fish and shellfish resources shall be administered under rules
- 21 adopted by the director and issued at no charge. The director shall
