## SENATE BILL 6175

- 1 AN ACT Relating to state government employment; adding new sections
- 2 to chapter 41.04 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 41.04 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The number of management employees employed by each agency of
- 7 state government shall not exceed the actual managerial employment
- 8 level of the agency on the effective date of this act unless each
- 9 additional management employee position has received the prior approval
- 10 of the committee on state government employment established under
- 11 section 2 of this act.
- 12 (2) As used in this section:

- 1 (a) "Agency of state government" means all departments, boards,
- 2 commissions, institutions, and other agencies of the executive branch
- 3 of state government; and
- 4 (b) "Number of management employees" means the number of persons
- 5 employed by the agency as directors, executive directors, secretaries,
- 6 administrators, chiefs, or superintendents and any such deputies,
- 7 assistants, or associates; all regional division, bureau, program, or
- 8 office administrators or managers and such deputies, assistants, or
- 9 associates; and all confidential or personal secretaries and
- 10 administrative or executive assistants to such officials employed by
- 11 any agency of state government.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.04 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (1) The limitation on state agency management employment
- 15 established by section 1 of this act shall be administered by a
- 16 committee on state government employment, which is hereby created.
- 17 (2) The committee shall consist of the following eight members:
- 18 (a) Four persons appointed by, and who shall serve at the pleasure
- 19 of, the governor. The governor shall designate one of these members to
- 20 serve as the chair of the committee; and
- 21 (b) Four persons appointed by, and who shall serve at the pleasure
- 22 of, the largest labor organization in the state representing state
- 23 employees classified under the state civil service system, chapter
- 24 41.06 RCW.
- 25 (3) Members of the committee shall not receive any additional
- 26 compensation for their services but shall be reimbursed for travel
- 27 expenses as provided in RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.
- 28 (4) Staff and administrative support to the committee shall be
- 29 provided by the department of personnel.

- 1 (5) The committee shall adopt such rules under chapter 34.05 RCW as
- 2 are necessary to implement the limitation on state agency employment
- 3 established by section 1 of this act.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If any provision of this act or its
- 5 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 6 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 7 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 9 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 10 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 11 effect immediately.
