- 1 AN ACT Relating to service of process; and amending RCW 4.28.080.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 Sec. 1. RCW 4.28.080 and 1991 sp.s. c 30 s 28 are each amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 The summons shall be served by delivering a copy thereof, as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (1) If the action be against any county in this state, to the
- 8 county auditor or, during normal office hours, to the deputy auditor,
- 9 or in the case of a charter county, summons may be served upon the
- 10 agent, if any, designated by the legislative authority.
- 11 (2) If against any town or incorporated city in the state, to the
- 12 mayor, city manager, or, during normal office hours, to the mayor's or
- 13 city manager's designated agent or the city clerk thereof.

- 1 (3) If against a school or fire district, to the superintendent or
- 2 commissioner thereof or by leaving the same in his or her office with
- 3 an assistant superintendent, deputy commissioner, or business manager
- 4 during normal business hours.
- 5 (4) If against a railroad corporation, to any station, freight,
- 6 ticket or other agent thereof within this state.
- 7 (5) If against a corporation owning or operating sleeping cars, or
- 8 hotel cars, to any person having charge of any of its cars or any agent
- 9 found within the state.
- 10 (6) If against a domestic insurance company, to any agent
- 11 authorized by such company to solicit insurance within this state.
- 12 (7) If against a foreign or alien insurance company, as provided in
- 13 chapter 48.05 RCW.
- 14 (8) If against a company or corporation doing any express business,
- 15 to any agent authorized by said company or corporation to receive and
- 16 deliver express matters and collect pay therefor within this state.
- 17 (9) If the suit be against a company or corporation other than
- 18 those designated in the preceding subdivisions of this section, to the
- 19 president or other head of the company or corporation, the registered
- 20 agent, secretary, cashier or managing agent thereof or to the
- 21 secretary, stenographer or office assistant of the president or other
- 22 head of the company or corporation, registered agent, secretary,
- 23 cashier or managing agent.
- 24 (10) If the suit be against a foreign corporation or nonresident
- 25 joint stock company, partnership or association doing business within
- 26 this state, to any agent, cashier or secretary thereof.
- 27 (11) If against a minor under the age of fourteen years, to such
- 28 minor personally, and also to his or her father, mother, guardian, or
- 29 if there be none within this state, then to any person having the care

- 1 or control of such minor, or with whom he or she resides, or in whose
- 2 service he or she is employed, if such there be.
- 3 (12) If against any person for whom a guardian has been appointed
- 4 for any cause, then to such guardian.
- 5 (13) If against a foreign or alien steamship company or steamship
- 6 charterer, to any agent authorized by such company or charterer to
- 7 solicit cargo or passengers for transportation to or from ports in the
- 8 state of Washington.
- 9 (14) If against a self-insurance program regulated by chapter 48.62
- 10 RCW, as provided in chapter 48.62 RCW.
- 11 (15) <u>If against a marital community, to either spouse personally,</u>
- 12 or by leaving a copy of the summons at the house of either spouse's
- 13 usual abode with some person of suitable age and discretion then
- 14 resident therein. If the spouses are legally separated, each must be
- 15 <u>served as for personal service on an individual.</u>
- 16 (16) In all other cases, to the defendant personally, or by leaving
- 17 a copy of the summons at the house of his or her usual abode with some
- 18 person of suitable age and discretion then resident therein.
- 19 Service made in the modes provided in this section shall be taken
- 20 and held to be personal service.
