## SECOND SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 6197

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1992 Regular Session

- 1 AN ACT Relating to establishing Hood Canal as a marine fish
- 2 preservation area; adding new sections to Title 75 RCW; and creating
- 3 new sections.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that:
- 6 (1) Hood Canal is one of the state's most valuable food fish
- 7 producing areas;
- 8 (2) Maintaining and enhancing the food fish resource in Hood Canal
- 9 is in the best interests of the state;
- 10 (3) Fishing opportunity in Hood Canal has declined in recent years;
- 11 (4) It is important to halt this decline; and
- 12 (5) The department of fisheries should continue to seek additional
- 13 actions that will increase the food fish resource in Hood Canal and
- 14 enhance fishing opportunity.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to Title 75 RCW to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 All marine waters lying south of the Hood Canal floating bridge
- 4 shall be designated as a "unique marine resources area." This
- 5 designation is intended to preserve, protect, and enhance the food fish
- 6 resource, to improve the productivity of the resource, and to encourage
- 7 the full development of fishing opportunities.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to Title 75 RCW to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 In seeking to improve the food fish resource in Hood Canal, the
- 11 department shall consider additional area closures for food fish,
- 12 additional gear restrictions, reprogramming of Hood Canal salmon
- 13 hatcheries, increasing efforts with nonprofit volunteer organizations,
- 14 and a reduction of fishing effort by adjusting the number of vessels
- 15 fishing at a given time. The department shall take appropriate
- 16 administrative action to advise the public of areas closed to the
- 17 taking of food fish.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The department of fisheries shall
- 19 conduct a study for the purpose of determining the cause of the decline
- 20 in runs of Hood Canal origin coho, which might be the result of habitat
- 21 and survival conditions in the canal or the result of other causes.
- 22 This study shall formulate recommendations to the legislature
- 23 concerning appropriate specific actions which should be taken to
- 24 correct any problems which are identified and their respective
- 25 practicality. The department shall report the results of this study to
- 26 the legislature not later than December 31, 1992.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** The department of fisheries shall
- 2 provide a report to the legislature regarding actions taken to
- 3 implement section 3 of this act. The report shall be provided to the
- 4 legislature not later than December 31, 1992.
