- 1 AN ACT Relating to electricians; and amending RCW 19.28.530.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 Sec. 1. RCW 19.28.530 and 1988 c 81 s 13 are each amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 (1) Upon receipt of the application, the department shall review
- 6 the application and determine whether the applicant is eligible to take
- 7 an examination for the journeyman or specialty certificate of
- 8 competency.
- 9 (a) To be eligible to take the examination for a journeyman
- 10 certificate the applicant must have worked in the electrical
- 11 construction trade for a minimum of four years employed full time, of
- 12 which two years shall be in industrial or commercial electrical
- 13 installation under the supervision of a journeyman electrician
- 14 certified under this chapter and not more than a total of two years in

- 1 all specialties under the supervision of a journeyman electrician
- 2 certified under this chapter or an appropriate specialty electrician
- 3 certified under this chapter or have successfully completed an
- 4 apprenticeship program approved under chapter 49.04 RCW for the
- 5 electrical construction trade.
- 6 (b) To be eligible to take the examination to become a specialty
- 7 electrician the applicant shall have worked in that specialty of the
- 8 electrical construction trade, under the supervision of a journeyman
- 9 electrician certified under this chapter or an appropriate specialty
- 10 electrician certified under this chapter, for a minimum of two years
- 11 employed full time, or have successfully completed an approved
- 12 apprenticeship program under chapter 49.04 RCW for the applicant's
- 13 specialty in the electrical construction trade. Before January 1,
- 14 1984, applicants for nonresidential maintenance specialty licenses are
- 15 eligible to become nonresidential maintenance specialists upon
- 16 certification to the department that they have the equivalent of two
- 17 years full-time experience in that specialty field.
- 18 <u>(c)</u> Persons applying before January 1, 1984, for a journeyman
- 19 certificate are eligible to take the examination to become journeymen
- 20 until July 1, 1984, upon certification to the department that they have
- 21 the equivalent of five years full-time experience in nonresidential
- 22 maintenance, of which two years shall be in industrial electrical
- 23 installation.
- 24 (d) Any applicant who has successfully completed a two-year
- 25 technical school program in the electrical construction trade in a
- 26 school that is approved by the ((commission for vocational education))
- 27 <u>director</u> may substitute up to two years of the technical school program
- 28 for two years of work experience under a journeyman electrician. The
- 29 applicant shall obtain the additional two years of work experience
- 30 required in industrial or commercial electrical installation prior to

- 1 the beginning, or after the completion, of the technical school
 2 program.
- 3 (e) Any applicant who has received his or her training in the
- 4 electrical construction trade in the armed service of the United States
- 5 may be eligible to take the examination for the certificate of
- 6 competency. Any applicant who is a graduate of a trade school program
- 7 in the electrical construction trade that was established during 1946
- 8 is eligible to take the examination for the certificate of competency.
- 9 No other requirement for eligibility may be imposed.
- 10 (f) An applicant who has received his or her training or work
- 11 <u>experience in an electrical trade as an employee of the federal</u>
- 12 government and has successfully completed a four-year apprenticeship
- 13 program administered by the federal government in the electrical
- 14 construction trade may take the examination for the certificate of
- 15 competency. No other requirement for eligibility may be imposed.
- 16 (2) The department shall establish reasonable rules for the
- 17 examinations to be given applicants for certificates of competency. In
- 18 establishing the rules, the department shall consult with the board.
- 19 Upon determination that the applicant is eligible to take the
- 20 examination, the department shall so notify the applicant, indicating
