- 1 AN ACT Relating to supporting threatened or endangered food fish;
- 2 amending RCW 46.16.605; and adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) A resident of this state may, in addition to the application
- 7 required by RCW 46.16.040, apply to the department for a set of license
- 8 plates designed by the department that indicates the recipient of the
- 9 plates supports the state's efforts to protect and enhance salmon and
- 10 other food fish listed as threatened or endangered by the national
- 11 marine fisheries service pursuant to the federal endangered species
- 12 act.
- 13 (2) In addition to the regular registration fee and any other fees
- 14 and taxes required to be paid upon registration, the applicant shall be

- 1 charged a fee of twenty dollars. In addition to the regular renewal
- 2 fee and in addition to any other fees and taxes required to be paid,
- 3 the applicant for a renewal of such plates shall be charged an
- 4 additional fee of fifteen dollars.
- 5 (3) Fees received by the department for purchase of special license
- 6 plates described in this section shall be deposited to the state
- 7 wildlife fund in accordance with RCW 46.16.605.
- 8 (4) The plate shall remain with the recipient upon transfer or
- 9 other disposition of the vehicle, and may be used on another motor
- 10 vehicle registered to the recipient in accordance with RCW 46.16.595
- 11 for such transfers.
- 12 Sec. 2. RCW 46.16.605 and 1988 c 36 s 27 are each amended to read
- 13 as follows:
- 14 All revenue derived from the fees provided for in RCW 46.16.585
- 15 shall be forwarded to the state treasurer and be deposited to the
- 16 credit of the state wildlife fund to be used for the preservation,
- 17 protection, perpetuation, and enhancement of nongame species of
- 18 wildlife including but not limited to song birds, raptors, protected
- 19 wildlife, rare and endangered wildlife, aquatic life, and specialized-
- 20 habitat types, both terrestrial and aquatic, as well as all
- 21 unclassified marine fish, shellfish, and marine invertebrates.
- 22 Administrative costs incurred by the department of licensing as a
- 23 direct result of RCW 46.16.560 through 46.16.605, section 1 of this
- 24 act, and 77.12.170 shall be appropriated by the legislature from the
- 25 state wildlife fund from those funds deposited therein resulting from
- 26 the sale of personalized license plates and license plates issued under
- 27 <u>section 1 of this act</u>. If the actual costs incurred by the department
- 28 of licensing are less than that which has been appropriated by the
- 29 legislature the remainder shall revert to the state wildlife fund.
