- AN ACT Relating to transit funding; amending RCW 82.44.180; and
- 2 adding a new chapter to Title 47 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 82.44.180 and 1991 c 199 s 224 are each amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) The transportation fund is created in the state treasury.
- 7 Revenues under RCW 82.44.020 (1) and (2), 82.44.110, 82.44.150, and the
- 8 surcharge under RCW 82.50.510 shall be deposited into the fund as
- 9 provided in those sections.
- 10 Moneys in the fund may be spent only after appropriation.
- 11 Expenditures from the fund may be used only for transportation
- 12 purposes.
- 13 (2) There is hereby created the central Puget Sound public
- 14 transportation account within the transportation fund. Moneys

- 1 deposited into the account under RCW 82.44.150(2)(b) shall be
- 2 ((expended)) appropriated to the department of transportation and
- 3 allocated under section 2 of this act to public transportation projects
- 4 within the three_county region from which the funds are derived, solely
- 5 for:
- 6 (a) <u>Planning;</u>
- 7 <u>(b) Development of transit-related capital projects;</u>
- 8 (c) Development of high capacity transportation systems as defined
- 9 in RCW 81.104.010;
- 10 $((\frac{b}{b}))$ (d) Development of high occupancy vehicle lanes and related
- 11 facilities as defined in RCW 81.100.020; and
- 12 (((c))) (e) Public transportation system contributions required to
- 13 fund projects under federal programs and those approved by the
- 14 transportation improvement board.
- 15 (3) There is hereby created the public transportation systems
- 16 account within the transportation fund. Moneys deposited into the
- 17 account under RCW 82.44.150(2)(c) shall be ((available to))
- 18 appropriated to the department of transportation and allocated under
- 19 <u>section 2 of this act to public transportation projects submitted by</u>
- 20 the public transportation systems from which the funds are derived,
- 21 solely for:
- 22 (a) Planning;
- 23 <u>(b) Development of transit-related capital projects;</u>
- 24 (c) Development of high capacity transportation systems as defined
- 25 in RCW 81.104.010;
- $((\frac{b}{b}))$ (d) Development of high occupancy vehicle lanes and related
- 27 facilities as defined in RCW 81.100.020;
- (((c))) (e) Other public transportation system-related roadway
- 29 projects on state highways, county roads, or city streets; ((and))

- 1 $((\frac{d}{d}))$ (f) Public transportation system contributions required to
- 2 fund projects under federal programs and those approved by the
- 3 transportation improvement board; and
- 4 (g) Acquisition of facilities and equipment for newly established
- 5 transit systems.
- 6 The department shall give preference to applications submitted
- 7 under (g) of this subsection.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new chapter is added to Title 47 RCW to
- 9 read as follows:
- To help achieve the goals identified in the public transportation
- 11 policy plan required by RCW 47.--.-- (section 1, chapter ---, Laws of
- 12 1992 (HB--)), the department shall allocate to transit agencies amounts
- 13 appropriated from the central Puget Sound public transportation account
- 14 created by RCW 82.44.180(2), and from the public transportation systems
- 15 account created by RCW 82.44.180(3). The department shall make the
- 16 allocations in accordance with the following procedures:
- 17 (1) By July 1, 1992, the department shall submit to the legislative
- 18 transportation committee the management plan by which the allocation
- 19 process will be governed, including identification of any local match
- 20 requirements.
- 21 (2) By August 1, 1992, and by July 1st of each even-numbered year
- 22 thereafter, transit agencies shall apply to the department for funding
- 23 in the ensuing biennium from the appropriate account, for the types of
- 24 projects identified in RCW 82.44.180(2) or (3).
- 25 (3) The department shall establish an advisory council of policy
- 26 and technical experts to assist in the review and prioritization of
- 27 requests from transit agencies. Council representation shall include
- 28 transit agencies of varying size and from various geographic regions of
- 29 the state.

- 1 (4) The department shall include in its biennial budget request
- 2 submitted to the office of financial management and the legislative
- 3 transportation committee the prioritized list of projects proposed to
- 4 be funded from each account in the ensuing biennium.
- 5 To the extent possible, the department shall allocate the amount
- 6 appropriated by the legislature from each account to transit agency
- 7 projects in the order of priority for each account.
- 8 For the purposes of this chapter, "transit agency" means an agency
- 9 that imposes a motor vehicle excise tax under RCW 35.58.273, and, if
- 10 authorized by the legislature, regional transit authorities.
