- 1 AN ACT Relating to food products requiring insurance or proof of

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Unless the context clearly requires
- 6 otherwise, the definition in this section applies throughout this
- 7 chapter. "Food products delivery guarantee" means a statement
- 8 guaranteeing or warranting the time of delivery for the retail sale of
- 9 a prepared food product or service.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **Sec. 2.** A person may bring a civil action for
- 11 injuries or damages proximately caused by a food products delivery
- 12 guarantee. Damages may include nominal, compensatory, and punitive
- 13 damages. Costs and attorneys' fees shall be awarded by the court to a

- 2 to remedies otherwise provided by law.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** When a court finds that a person made a
- 4 food products delivery guarantee that proximately resulted in injury or
- 5 damage to another or another's property, the attorney general of the
- 6 state of Washington may petition the court on behalf of the state for
- 7 a civil penalty of five thousand dollars for each occurrence of injury
- 8 or damage.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** All retail prepared food delivery
- 10 businesses, shall have public liability insurance for nonowned motor
- 11 vehicles used by employees for delivery purposes. The minimum coverage
- 12 shall be two hundred fifty thousand dollars for injury or damage to
- 13 property per occurrence and two hundred fifty thousand dollars for
- 14 injury or damage, including death, to any one person and five hundred
- 15 twenty-five thousand dollars for injury or damage, including death, to
- 16 more than one person.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** This chapter may be known and cited as
