- 1 WHEREAS, It is of paramount importance to establish cutoff dates
- 2 for the consideration of legislation during the 1991 Regular Session of
- 3 the Fifty-Second Legislature;
- 4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of
- 5 the State of Washington, the Senate concurring, That the following
- 6 cutoff dates apply to all bills, memorials, and joint resolutions with
- 7 the exception of budgets, matters necessary to implement budgets, and
- 8 initiatives to the legislature:
- 9 (1) Wednesday, March 6, 1991, the fifty-second day, will be the
- 10 final day to read in committee reports in the house of origin with the
- 11 exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means and House fiscal
- 12 committees;
- 13 (2) Monday, March 11, 1991, the fifty-seventh day, will be the
- 14 final day to read in Senate Ways and Means and House fiscal committee
- 15 reports in the house of origin;
- 16 (3) Wednesday, March 20, 1991, the sixty-sixth day, at 5:00 p.m.,
- 17 will be the final time to consider bills in their house of origin with

- 1 the exception of Senate Bill No. 5149, House Bill No. 1025, House Bill
- 2 No. 1434, and Engrossed House Bill No. 1868;
- 3 (4) Friday, April 5, 1991, the eighty-second day, will be the final
- 4 day to read in committee reports on bills from the opposite house with
- 5 the exception of reports pertaining to Senate Bill No. 5149, House Bill
- 6 No. 1025, House Bill No. 1434, and Engrossed House Bill No. 1868 and
- 7 reports from the Senate Ways and Means and House fiscal committees;
- 8 (5) Monday, April 8, 1991, the eighty-fifth day, will be the final
- 9 day to read in Senate Ways and Means and House fiscal committee reports
- 10 on bills from the opposite house except for reports pertaining to
- 11 Senate Bill No. 5149, House Bill No. 1025, House Bill No. 1434, and
- 12 Engrossed House Bill No. 1868; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That after 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 19,
- 14 1991, the ninety-sixth day, neither house may consider any bills,
- 15 memorials, or joint resolutions except initiatives to the legislature,
- 16 messages pertaining to amendments, matters of differences between the
- 17 two houses, conference and free conference reports, and matters
- 18 incident to the interim and to the closing of the business of the 1991
- 19 Regular Session of the Legislature.
