- 1 TO THE HONORABLE RICHARD CHENEY, SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, AND TO
- 2 GENERAL COLIN POWELL, CHAIR OF THE JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF, AND TO THE
- 3 ARMED FORCES PARTICIPATING IN OPERATIONS DESERT SHIELD AND DESERT
- 4 STORM:
- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate of the State of Washington, in
- 6 legislative session assembled, respectfully represent and petition as
- 7 follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, The Nation of Kuwait has been since August of 1990,
- 9 subject to the military oppression of an invading force, the military
- 10 machine of the president of Iraq, Saddam Hussein; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Economic sanctions, coupled with a deadline resolution of
- 12 the United Nations, failed to convince Saddam Hussein to leave Kuwait;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, The President of the United States, resolved to act
- 15 against Saddam Hussein and through the efforts of the United Nations,
- 16 a coalition of nearly thirty nations joined together to present a
- 17 unified front to protest this invasion of one country by another; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The war inevitably involved half a million men and women
- 2 from across the nation, with eight thousand individuals coming from
- 3 Washington state; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Those men and women are our neighbors, their children play
- 5 with our children, and they serve our communities through times of
- 6 peace as well as in this time of war; and
- WHEREAS, The people of the state of Washington are united in their
- 8 support for the men and women who serve in our armed forces and we
- 9 wholeheartedly support their efforts on our behalf and on behalf of the
- 10 world; and
- 11 WHEREAS, We pray for the successful accomplishment of their mission
- 12 and for their safe return;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 14 Department of Defense and the Joint Chiefs of Staff extend our
- 15 appreciation to all our troops, especially those personnel representing
- 16 the state of Washington in this serious time of crisis and courage.
- 17 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 18 transmitted to the Honorable Richard Cheney, Secretary of Defense, and
- 19 to General Colin Powell, Chair of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, and to
- 20 Honorable George Mitchell, President of the Senate, and to Honorable
- 21 Tom Foley, Speaker of the House of Representatives.
