- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, The United States Constitution, Article IV, section 3
- 9 states in part that ". . . no new state shall be formed or erected
- 10 within the jurisdiction of any other state; nor any state be formed by
- 11 the junction of two or more states, or parts of states, without the
- 12 consent of the legislatures of the states concerned as well as of the
- 13 congress."; and
- 14 WHEREAS, That portion of the state from the crest of the Cascade
- 15 Mountains east to the existing state border, including the Wenatchee
- 16 and Yakima valleys, has sought and desired to become a separate and
- 17 independent state; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The legislators of the state of Washington do agree with
- 2 and consent to that desire to create a new state from the territory
- 3 herein mentioned;
- 4 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 5 Congress of the United States consent to the formation of a new state
- 6 whose western boundary is the crest of the Cascade Mountains and whose
- 7 eastern, northern, and southern boundaries are the existing state
- 8 borders, to include the Wenatchee and Yakima valleys.
- 9 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 10 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
- 11 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
- 12 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
- 13 Washington.
