- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, Military action, social unrest, and economic instability
- 9 in the Middle East could seriously disrupt the supply of oil to the
- 10 United States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Oil is a major source of energy in our nation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Since the onset of the Industrial Revolution, energy has
- 13 been the lifeblood of economic activity and growth; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Continued economic development in an increasingly
- 15 competitive world marketplace requires affordable and reliable supplies
- 16 of energy resources; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Energy imports account for approximately one-fourth of the
- 2 national balance of trade deficit; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Our nation's high levels of fossil fuel consumption have
- 4 created ozone and carbon monoxide hazards that choke our cities and
- 5 acid rain that destroys forestry and fisheries resources; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Existing patterns of energy use may be creating a climatic
- 7 "greenhouse effect" that could dramatically reduce agricultural
- 8 productivity; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Our nation is blessed with abundant domestic energy
- 10 resources and technology, including coal, gas, oil, and uranium
- 11 supplies and renewable resources that can meet our needs and reduce our
- 12 reliance on imports;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 14 President of the United States and the United States Congress, to
- 15 ensure a stable, economic, and environmentally beneficial supply of
- 16 domestic energy resources, direct the development of a comprehensive
- 17 national energy policy that examines the costs and benefits of all
- 18 resource alternatives to best promote and encourage the development of
- 19 domestic clean energy supplies and increased energy efficiency.
- 20 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 21 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
- 22 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
- 23 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
- 24 Washington.
