- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED, AND TO THE UNITED STATES FOREST
- 5 SERVICE:
- 6 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 7 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 8 represent and petition as follows:
- 9 WHEREAS, The timber industry in the State of Washington is in
- 10 serious economic decline; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Timber jobs, which support the communities, families, and
- 12 related businesses, are in jeopardy due to altered policies caused by
- 13 the program for the protection of the spotted owl and changes in the
- 14 timber industry; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Timber which has been blown down in several national
- 2 forests in this state can be salvaged and consists of an estimated
- 3 total of seventy million one hundred thirty thousand board feet; and
- 4 WHEREAS, A carefully supervised removal of downed trees using
- 5 environmentally sound silviculture methods can produce timber for local
- 6 mills while at the same time leaving an undamaged old growth forest;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Some logs can be left to decay and contribute to rich,
- 9 fresh soil; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Careful removal of the timber using existing roads will
- 11 reduce the potential for extensive bug infestation that could damage
- 12 the forest; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Salvage sales could provide fifteen to twenty jobs per
- 14 million board feet of salvaged timber; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The sales are supported by the Governor's Timber Policy
- 16 Team as well as the legislature;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 18 President and Congress pass legislation authorizing the United States
- 19 Forest Service to offer salvage sales of blown down timber in the
- 20 Pacific Northwest National Forests allowing the state to reap the
- 21 economic and environmental benefits.
- 22 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 23 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
- 24 States, the United States Forest Service, the President of the United
- 25 States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and to each
- 26 member of Congress from the State of Washington.
