Brief Description: Granting paid leave for employees who are in training or on call as volunteer members of the emergency services.

**HB 1047-S - DIGEST**

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Requires the provision of paid leave for employees in training or on call as volunteer fire fighters, law enforcement officers, search and rescue team members, or emergency medical technicians.

Places a limit of ten days on the leave.

Requires monitoring of the leave program for a report to the 1992 legislature.
