Brief Description: Licensing private security guards.

HB 1180-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/18/91)

Provides that a person is guilty of a gross misdemeanor if he or she performs the functions of a private security guard without obtaining a license.

Designates additional gross misdemeanor offenses.

Provides for a civil penalty for any person violating an injunction.

Establishes the requirements to obtain a private security guard license.

Requires security guards to maintain minimum insurance coverage.

Specifies prohibited acts which constitute grounds for disciplinary actions.

Directs the criminal justice training commission to establish a program for issuing firearm certificates.
