Brief Description: Providing additional unemployment insurance benefits and training for certain lumber and wood products workers.

HB 1599-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/14/91)

Provides that claims for additional benefits must be established before July 3, 1993.

Provides formulas to calculate the weekly benefit amount.

Authorizes additional benefits only if the claimant enters and makes satisfactory progress in a training program.

Excludes benefits for on-the-job training.
