Brief Description: Addressing problems with health care coverage for retired and disabled public employees.

**HB 1796-S - DIGEST**

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/20/91)

Provides that retired or disabled employees eligible for medicare may be offered health care coverage that differs from that available to active employees.

Establishes a health care benefits study commission to prepare a report to the legislature by December 1, 1992.
