Brief Description: Providing malpractice insurance for retired physicians serving low-income patients.

HB 2337 - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 1ST SUB)

Establishes a program to alleviate the costs of malpractice insurance for retired physicians providing uncompensated health care services to low-income patients.

Prescribes the conditions for participation in the state-assisted liability insurance program.

Makes an appropriation of fifty thousand dollars to carry out the purposes of the program.
