Brief Description: Requiring salmon food fish to be labeled by its source and common name.

HB 2369-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/13/92)

Prohibits the sale of salmon without providing identification of the species by its common name and identification of the source from which the salmon has been obtained.

Designates the elements of the offense of misbranding.
