Brief Description: Changing the blood and breath alcohol content standards for intoxication for those persons under the age of twenty one.

SB 5069-S - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/25/92)

Provides that the alcohol concentration standard for persons under the age of twenty-one is any amount more than 0.04 grams of alcohol per two hundred ten liters of breath or 0.04 percent by weight of alcohol in the blood.

Provides that the alcohol concentration standard for persons over the age of twenty-one is any amount more than 0.08 grams of alcohol per two hundred ten liters of breath or 0.08 percent by weight of alcohol in the blood.
