Brief Description: Requiring English proficiency for faculty and graduate assistants involved in classroom teaching.

SB 5350-S - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 3/19/91)

Requires persons who have received a faculty or graduate assistant appointment to be fluent in both written and spoken English language.

Requires each state institution of higher education to submit a plan for certifying the instructional proficiencies of international teaching assistants.
