Brief Description: Requiring counties or cities considering wetlands protection ordinances to create an inventory and map of wetlands.

SB 6255-S2 - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/17/92)

Requires the development of an inventory of wetlands prior to the adoption of regulations.

Requires the counties and cities to mail a notice of proposed wetland regulation to affected landowners.

Specifies publication of notice requirements.

Requires a copy of the regulations and inventory to be provided to the county assessor's office.

Authorizes the study of the feasibility of contracting with public or private agencies to expedite the development of wetland maps.

Establishes procedures for the revaluation of property designated as wetlands.

Provides that the act shall be null and void if appropriations are not approved.
