

1 **SHB 1662 - H COMM AMD ADOPTED 03-13-93**

2 By Committee on Capital Budget

3 On page 3, after line 2, insert:

4 "Sec. 2. RCW 43.160.030 and 1987 c 422 s 2 are each amended
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The community economic revitalization board is hereby
7 created to exercise the powers granted under this chapter.

8 (2) The board shall consist of the chairman of and one
9 minority member appointed by the speaker of the house of
10 representatives from the committee on trade and economic
11 development of the house of representatives, the chairman of and
12 one minority member appointed by the president of the senate from
13 the committee on commerce and labor of the senate, or the
14 equivalent standing committees, and the following members appointed
15 by the governor: A recognized private or public sector economist;
16 one port district official; one county official; one city official;
17 one representative of the public; one representative of small
18 businesses each from: (a) The area west of Puget Sound, (b) the
19 area east of Puget Sound and west of the Cascade range, (c) the
20 area east of the Cascade range and west of the Columbia river, and
21 (d) the area east of the Columbia river; one executive from large
22 businesses each from the area west of the Cascades and the area
23 east of the Cascades. The appointive members shall initially be
24 appointed to terms as follows: Three members for one-year terms,
25 three members for two-year terms, and three members for three-year
26 terms which shall include the chair. Thereafter each succeeding
27 term shall be for three years. The chair of the board shall be
28 selected by the governor (~~and should be a member of the governor's~~
29 ~~council of economic advisors~~). The members of the board shall

1 elect one of their members to serve as vice-chair. The director of
2 trade and economic development, the director of community
3 development, the director of revenue, the commissioner of
4 employment security, and the secretary of transportation shall
5 serve as nonvoting advisory members of the board.

6 (3) Staff support shall be provided by the department of trade
7 and economic development to assist the board in implementing this
8 chapter and the allocation of private activity bonds.

9 (4) All appointive members of the board shall be compensated
10 in accordance with RCW 43.03.240 and shall be reimbursed for travel
11 expenses as provided in RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.

12 (5) If a vacancy occurs by death, resignation, or otherwise of
13 appointive members of the board, the governor shall fill the same
14 for the unexpired term. Any members of the board, appointive or
15 otherwise, may be removed for malfeasance or misfeasance in office,
16 upon specific written charges by the governor, under chapter 34.05
17 RCW."

18 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct internal
19 references accordingly.

EFFECT: Eliminates the requirement that the CERB chair be a
member of the Governor's Council of Economic Advisors.
