13 obligor's nonexempt disposable earnings between or among the various  
14 obligees equally. An obligee may seek a court order reapportioning the  
15 obligor's nonexempt disposable earnings upon notice to all interested  
16 obligees. Notice shall be by personal service, or in the manner  
17 provided by the civil rules of superior court or applicable statute."
