5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 "Sec. 1. RCW 88.12.275 and 1986 c 217 s 11 are each amended to  
8 read as follows:

9 (1) Any person carrying passengers for hire on whitewater river  
10 sections in this state (~~may~~) shall register with the department of  
11 licensing. Each registration application shall be submitted annually  
12 on a form provided by the department of licensing and shall include the  
13 following information:

14 (a) The name, residence address, and residence telephone number,  
15 and the business name, address, and telephone number of the registrant;

16 (b) Proof that the registrant has liability insurance for a minimum  
17 of three hundred thousand dollars per (~~claim~~) person for occurrences  
18 by the registrant and the registrant's employees that result in bodily  
19 injury or property damage; and

20 (c) Certification that the registrant will maintain the insurance  
21 for a period of not less than one year from the date of registration.

22 (2) The department of licensing shall charge a fee for each  
23 application, to be set in accordance with RCW 43.24.086.

24 (3) Any person advertising or representing themselves as having  
25 registered under this section who is not currently registered is guilty  
26 of a gross misdemeanor.

27 (4) The department of licensing shall submit annually a list of  
28 registered persons and companies to the department of community, trade,  
29 and economic development, tourism promotion division.

30 (5) If an insurance company cancels or refuses to renew insurance  
31 for a registrant during the period of registration, the insurance  
32 company shall notify the department of licensing in writing of the  
33 termination of coverage and its effective date not less than thirty  
34 days before the effective date of termination.

35 (a) Upon receipt of an insurance company termination notice, the  
36 department of licensing shall send written notice to the registrant

1 that on the effective date of termination the department of licensing  
2 will suspend the registration unless proof of insurance as required by  
3 this section is filed with the department of licensing before the  
4 effective date of the termination.

5 (b) If an insurance company fails to give notice of coverage  
6 termination, this failure shall not have the effect of continuing the  
7 coverage.

8 (c) The department of licensing may suspend or revoke registration  
9 under this section if the registrant fails to maintain in full force  
10 and effect the insurance required by this section.

11 (6) The state of Washington shall be immune from any civil action  
12 arising from a registration under this section."
