- 8 (1) The department may at any time inquire into wages, hours, and
- 9 conditions of labor of minors employed in any trade, business, or
- 10 occupation in the state of Washington and may adopt special rules for
- 11 the protection of the safety, health, and welfare of minor employees.
- 12 Minor employees enrolled in an approved vocational education program
- 13 are permitted to operate equipment necessary for the occupation, trade,
- 14 or industry as long as the minor has completed training on equipment
- 15 that is similar to the equipment used in the occupation, trade, or
- 16 <u>industry</u>. However, the rules may not limit the hours per day or per
- 17 week, or other specified work period, that may be worked by minors who
- 18 are emancipated by court order.
- 19 (2) The department shall issue work permits to employers for the
- 20 employment of minors, after being assured the proposed employment of a
- 21 minor meets the standards for the health, safety, and welfare of minors
- 22 as set forth in the rules adopted by the department. No minor person
- 23 shall be employed in any occupation, trade, or industry subject to this
- 24 1973 amendatory act, unless a work permit has been properly issued,
- 25 with the consent of the parent, guardian, or other person having legal
- 26 custody of the minor and with the approval of the school which such

- 27 minor may then be attending. However, the consent of a parent,
- 28 guardian, or other person, or the approval of the school which the
- 29 minor may then be attending, is unnecessary if the minor is emancipated
- 30 by court order.
- 31 (3) The minimum wage for minors shall be as prescribed in RCW
- 32 49.46.020."
- 33 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
- 34 internal references accordingly.

1 <u>EFFECT:</u> Permits minors to use equipment that they have received 2 training on from an approved vocational technical school.
