3 On page 35, after line 13, insert:

4 "(5) The department shall provide additional assistance to  
5 community-based efforts in skill development, employment  
6 readiness, and work experience, including: (a) Community-based  
7 mentoring programs, providing technical assistance and providing  
8 funds for program development; (b) tutoring services to at-risk  
9 youth by the retired senior volunteer program; and (c) private-  
10 sector efforts to assist in the employment and training of at-  
11 risk youth in such areas as work experience, mentoring programs,  
12 skill development, and apprenticeships. In developing and  
13 implementing these efforts, the department shall consult with the  
14 work force training and education coordinating board, employment  
15 security department, and other relevant agencies. The department  
16 shall provide funds to community-based organizations to identify  
17 at-risk youth to participate in private-sector efforts and to  
18 provide ongoing assistance to youth participating in the  
19 programs."

Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct internal references accordingly.

**EFFECT:** Allows funds from the safe schools-safe communities grant program to be used for skill development, employment readiness, and work experience for at-risk youth through community-based and private-sector efforts.
