- 5 On page 10, beginning on line 9, strike all of section 15 and 6 insert the following:
- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 15. A new section is added to chapter 34.05 8 RCW to read as follows:
- 9 (1) An agency may immediately impose a penalty otherwise provided 10 for by law for a violation of an administrative rule only if the entity 11 on which the penalty will be imposed has: (a) Previously violated the 12 same rule; or (b) willfully violated the rule. If a penalty is 13 otherwise provided, but may not be imposed under this subsection, the 14 agency shall issue a statement of deficiency.
- 15 (2) A statement of deficiency shall specify: (a) The particular 16 rule violated; (b) the steps the entity must take to comply with the 17 rule; (c) agency personnel designated by the agency to provide technical assistance regarding compliance with the rule; and (d) a date 18 19 by which the entity is required to comply with the rule. 20 specified shall provide a reasonable period of time for the entity to comply with the rule, considering the size of the entity, its available 21 22 resources, and the threat posed by the violation. If the entity fails 23 to comply with the rule by the date specified, it shall be subject to the penalty otherwise provided in law. 24
- 25 (3) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to any violation 26 that places a person in danger of death or substantial bodily harm, is 27 causing or is likely to cause significant environmental harm, or has 28 caused or is likely to cause physical damage to the property of others 29 in an amount exceeding one thousand dollars.
- 30 (4) The state, the agency, and officers or employees of the state 31 shall not be liable for damages to any person to the extent that 32 liability is asserted to arise from the technical assistance provided 33 under this section, or if liability is asserted to arise from the 34 failure of the agency to supply technical assistance.
- 35 (5) If a state agency has been delegated authority to enforce 36 federal rules, the agency shall submit a written petition to the

- 1 appropriate federal agency for authorization to comply with this
- 2 section for all inspections while retaining the state's federal
- 3 delegation. If the federal agency fails to provide the authorization,
- 4 the agency shall comply with this section in all inspections except the
- 5 minimum number of inspections required by the federal government for
- 6 the program delegated to the state of Washington for enforcement."
