3 On page 62, after line 10 insert the following:

4 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 603. a new section is added to chapter  
5 9.91 to read as follows:

6 (1) As part of its annual crime statistics report, the  
7 Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs shall  
8 include information on arrests for violations of curfews.

9 (2) The department of community, trade and economic  
10 development and the department of social and health services  
11 shall use information reported pursuant to subsection (1) of this  
12 section together with such other information as they may collect  
13 from local and state agencies to prepare and deliver annually to  
14 the legislature a report containing the following information:

15 (a) The fiscal impact of curfew enforcement on state and  
16 local governments:

17 (b) The effectiveness of curfews in reducing criminal  
18 activity by and against youth;

19 (c) The racial and ethnic proportionality of curfew  
20 enforcement; and

21 (d) The capacity of residential centers and other supervised  
22 facilities to accommodate youths who may need such facilities  
23 because of curfew violations.

24 (3) Beginning in 1995 and each year thereafter, the  
25 legislature shall review the data and reports received under this  
26 section."

Renumber the remaining sections and correct internal references.

**EFFECT:** Requires DCETD and DSHS to study and report on  
curfew enforcement regarding: cost, effectiveness, racial  
and ethnic proportionality, and system capacity.
