15 section 455 of this act."

16 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct
17 internal references accordingly.

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21 On page 154, after line 33 of the amendment, insert the following:
22 "(9) Employers of persons specified in RCW 51.12.020 are exempt
23 from the requirements of this section. This exemption may not be
24 construed as exempting an individual from the provisions of section 454
25 of this act."

26 EFFECT: Exempts employers of the following categories of workers
27 from employer mandates (same categories that are exempt from industrial
28 insurance):

29 Domestic Servants
30 Private Home Gardening, Repair, and Maintenance

- 1 Work Performed Outside the Scope of One's Employer
- 2 Services Provided for Sustenance or Aid From a Religious/Charitable
- 3 Provider
- 4 Sole Proprietors or Partners
- 5 Minors Working for their Parents on a Family Farm
- 6 Jockeys
- 7 Bona-Fide Corporate Officers
- 8 Certain Contracted Musicians and Entertainers
- 9 Certain Newspaper Carriers
- 10 Certain Independent Insurance Agents
- 11 Certain Booth Renters

12 Clarifies that such workers are eligible for the basic health plan
13 and premium subsidies if they meet eligibility requirements.

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
