- 1 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 49.60 RCW 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (1) For purposes of the term "disability" as used in this chapter, 4 homosexuality and bisexuality are not impairments and as such are not 5 disabilities under this act. Under this chapter, the term "disability" 6 shall not include:
- 7 (a) Transvestism, transsexualism, pedophilia, exhibitionism, 8 voyeurism, gender identity disorders not resulting from physical 9 impairments, or other sexual behavior disorders;
 - (b) Compulsive gambling, kleptomania, or pyromania; or

- 11 (c) Psychoactive substance use disorders resulting from current 12 illegal use of drugs.
- (2)(a) For purposes of this chapter, a person who is currently engaging in the illegal use of drugs, when the covered entity acts on the basis of such use, shall not be considered to have a disability.
- 16 (b) Nothing in (a) of this subsection may be construed to exclude 17 as an individual with a disability an individual who:
- (i) Has successfully completed a supervised drug rehabilitation program and is no longer engaging in the illegal use of drugs, or has otherwise been rehabilitated successfully and is no longer engaging in such use;
- (ii) Is participating in a supervised rehabilitation program and is no longer engaging in such use; or
- 24 (iii) Is erroneously regarded as engaging in such use, but is not 25 engaging in such use;
- 26 except that it shall not be a violation of this chapter for a covered
