## ESSB 6071 - H COMM AMD ADOPTED 3-3-94

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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 6 following:

7 "Sec. 1. RCW 53.36.100 and 1982 1st ex.s. c 3 s 1 are each amended 8 to read as follows:

9 (1) A port district having adopted a comprehensive scheme of harbor 10 improvements and industrial developments may thereafter raise revenue, for ((twelve)) six years only, and a second six years if the procedures 11 12 are followed under subsection (2) of this section, in addition to all 13 other revenues now authorized by law, by an annual levy not to exceed 14 forty-five cents per thousand dollars of assessed value against the 15 assessed valuation of the taxable property in such port district. addition, if voters approve a ballot proposition authorizing additional 16 levies by a simple majority vote, a port district located in a county 17 bordering on the Pacific Ocean having adopted a comprehensive scheme of 18 harbor improvements and industrial developments may impose these levies 19 for a third six-year period. 20 Said ((<del>levy</del>)) <u>levies</u> shall be used 21 exclusively for the exercise of the powers granted to port districts 22 under chapter 53.25 RCW except as provided in RCW 53.36.110. 23 of such taxes is herein authorized notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 84.52.050 and 84.52.043. The revenues derived from levies made 24 25 under RCW 53.36.100 and 53.36.110 not expended in the year in which the levies are made may be paid into a fund for future use in carrying out 26 27 the powers granted under chapter 53.25 RCW, which fund may be accumulated and carried over from year to year, with the right to 28 continue to levy the taxes provided for in RCW 53.36.100 and 53.36.110 29 30 for the purposes herein authorized.

(2) If a port district intends to levy a tax under this section for one or more years after the first six years ((authorized in this section)) these levies were imposed, the port commission shall publish notice of this intention, in one or more newspapers of general circulation within the district, by June 1 of the year in which the first levy of the seventh through twelfth year period is to be made.

If within ninety days of the date of publication a petition is filed with the county auditor containing the signatures of eight percent of 2 the number of voters registered and voting in the port district for the 3 4 office of the governor at the last preceding gubernatorial election, 5 the county auditor shall canvass the signatures in the same manner as prescribed in RCW 29.79.200 and certify their sufficiency to the port 6 7 commission within two weeks. The proposition to make these levies in 8 the seventh through twelfth year period shall be submitted to the 9 voters of the port district at a special election, called for this 10 purpose, no later than the date on which a primary election would be held under RCW 29.13.070. The levies may be made in the seventh 11 through twelfth year period only if approved by a majority of the 12 voters of the port district voting on the proposition." 13

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
