7 On page 3, line 28, after "issued" insert "except for persons
8 under the age of 16"

9 On page 3, line 28, after "violator" insert "age 16 or older"

10 On page 3, line 35, after "(4)" strike the remainder of the
11 subsection and insert "No person under the age of 16 violating
12 section 2 of this act shall be subject to a traffic infraction. In
13 lieu of a traffic infraction for a person under the age of 16, law
14 enforcement officers shall provide to the violator written
15 information about the importance of wearing helmets, where helmets
16 may be purchased or obtained at little or no cost, and the contents
17 of the law. Law enforcement officers shall encourage the violator
18 to share this information with his or her parent or guardian."
