7 "Sec. 1. RCW 28A.310.200 and 1990 c 159 s 1 and 1990 c 33 s 278
8 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

9 In addition to other powers and duties as provided by law, every
10 educational service district board shall:

11 (1) Approve the budgets of the educational service district in
12 accordance with the procedures provided for in this chapter.

13 (2) Meet regularly according to the schedule adopted at the
14 organization meeting and in special session upon the call of the chair
15 or a majority of the board.

16 (3) Approve the selection of educational service district personnel
17 and clerical staff as provided in RCW 28A.310.230.

18 (4) Fix the amount of and approve the bonds for those educational
19 service district employees designated by the board as being in need of
20 bonding.

21 (5) Keep in the educational service district office a full and
22 correct transcript of the boundaries of each school district within the
23 educational service district.

24 (6) Acquire by borrowing funds or by purchase, lease, devise,
25 bequest, and gift and otherwise contract for real and personal property
26 necessary for the operation of the educational service district and to
27 the execution of the duties of the board and superintendent thereof and
28 sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of that property not necessary for
29 district purposes. No real property shall be acquired or alienated
30 without the prior approval of the state board of education and the
31 acquisition or alienation of all such property shall be subject to such
32 provisions as the board may establish. When borrowing funds for the
33 purpose of acquiring property, the educational service district board
34 shall pledge as collateral the property to be acquired. Borrowing
35 shall be evidenced by a note or other instrument between the district
36 and the lender. The authority to borrow under this subsection shall be

1 limited to educational service districts serving a minimum of two
2 hundred thousand students in grades kindergarten through twelve.

3 (7) Under RCW 28A.310.010, upon the written request of the board of
4 directors of a local school district or districts served by the
5 educational service district, the educational service district board of
6 directors may provide cooperative and informational services not in
7 conflict with other law that provide for the development and
8 implementation of programs, activities, services, or practices that
9 support the education of preschool through twelfth grade students in
10 the public schools or that support the effective, efficient, or safe
11 management and operation of the school district or districts served by
12 the educational service district.

13 (8) Adopt such bylaws and rules and regulations for its own
14 operation as it deems necessary or appropriate.

15 ~~((+8))~~ (9) Enter into contracts, including contracts with common
16 and educational service districts and the school for the deaf and the
17 school for the blind for the joint financing of cooperative service
18 programs conducted pursuant to RCW 28A.310.180(3), and employ
19 consultants and legal counsel relating to any of the duties, functions,
20 and powers of the educational service districts.

21 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The Washington state institute for public
22 policy shall submit to the legislature by January 10, 1994, a report
23 with recommendations for the design of a comprehensive study of the
24 role and performance of educational service districts."
