5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 "**Sec. 1.** RCW 36.18.010 and 1991 c 26 s 2 are each amended to read  
8 as follows:

9 County auditors or recording officers shall collect the following  
10 fees for their official services:

11 For recording instruments, for the first page, legal size (eight  
12 and one-half by fourteen inches or less), five dollars; for each  
13 additional legal size page, one dollar; the fee for recording multiple  
14 transactions contained in one instrument will be calculated  
15 individually for each transaction requiring separate indexing as  
16 required under RCW 65.04.050;

17 For preparing and certifying copies, for the first legal size page,  
18 three dollars; for each additional legal size page, one dollar;

19 For preparing noncertified copies, for each legal size page, one  
20 dollar;

21 For administering an oath or taking an affidavit, with or without  
22 seal, two dollars;

23 For issuing a marriage license, (~~eight~~) fifteen dollars, (eight  
24 dollars of this fee ((includes)) is for the purpose of taking necessary  
25 affidavits, filing returns, indexing, and transmittal of a record of  
26 the marriage to the state registrar of vital statistics; the remainder  
27 is for the funding of family service centers) plus an additional five-  
28 dollar fee for use and support of the prevention of child abuse and  
29 neglect activities to be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer and  
30 deposited in the state general fund, which five-dollar fee shall expire  
31 June 30, 1995, plus an additional ten-dollar fee to be transmitted  
32 monthly to the state treasurer and deposited in the state general fund.  
33 The legislature intends to appropriate an amount at least equal to the  
34 revenue generated by this fee for the purposes of the displaced  
35 homemaker act, chapter 28B.04 RCW;

36 For searching records per hour, eight dollars;

1 For recording plats, fifty cents for each lot except cemetery plats  
2 for which the charge shall be twenty-five cents per lot; also one  
3 dollar for each acknowledgment, dedication, and description: PROVIDED,  
4 That there shall be a minimum fee of twenty-five dollars per plat;

5 For recording of miscellaneous records, not listed above, for first  
6 legal size page, five dollars; for each additional legal size page, one  
7 dollar;

8 For modernization and improvement of the recording and indexing  
9 system, a surcharge as provided in RCW 36.22.170."
