- 7 "Sec. 1. RCW 28A.335.190 and 1990 c 33 s 362 are each amended to 8 read as follows:
- (1) When, in the opinion of the board of directors of any school 9 10 district, the cost of any furniture, supplies, equipment, building, improvements, or repairs, or other work or purchases, except books, 11 12 will equal or exceed the sum of ((twenty)) fifty thousand dollars, 13 complete plans and specifications for such work or purchases shall be 14 prepared and notice by publication given in at least one newspaper of 15 general circulation within the district, once each week for two 16 consecutive weeks, of the intention to receive bids therefor and that 17 specifications and other information may be examined at the office of the board or any other officially designated location: PROVIDED, That 18 19 the board without giving such notice may make improvements or repairs 20 to the property of the district through the shop and repair department 21 of such district when the total of such improvements or repair does not 22 exceed the sum of ((seventy-five hundred)) fifteen thousand dollars. 23 The cost of any public work, improvement or repair for the purposes of 24 this section shall be the aggregate of all amounts to be paid for 25 labor, material, and equipment on one continuous or interrelated project where work is to be performed simultaneously or in close 26 27 sequence. The bids shall be in writing and shall be opened and read in public on the date and in the place named in the notice and after being 28 opened shall be filed for public inspection. 29
- 30 (2) Every purchase of furniture, equipment or supplies, except 31 books, the cost of which is estimated to be in excess of ((seventy-five 32 hundred)) fifteen thousand dollars, shall be on a competitive basis. 33 The board of directors shall establish a procedure for securing 34 telephone and/or written quotations for such purchases. Whenever the 35 estimated cost is from ((seventy-five hundred)) fifteen thousand 36 dollars up to ((twenty)) fifty thousand dollars, the procedure shall

- require quotations from at least three different sources to be obtained in writing or by telephone, and recorded for public perusal. Whenever the estimated cost is in excess of ((twenty)) fifty thousand dollars, the public bidding process provided in subsection (1) of this section shall be followed.
- (3) Every building, improvement, repair or other public works 6 7 project, the cost of which is estimated to be in excess of ((seventy-8 five hundred)) fifteen thousand dollars, shall be on a competitive bid 9 process. All such projects estimated to be less than ((twenty)) fifty 10 thousand dollars may be awarded to a contractor on the small works The small works roster shall be comprised of all responsible 11 contractors who have requested to be on the list. 12 The board of directors shall establish a procedure for securing telephone and/or 13 written quotations from the contractors on the small works roster to 14 15 assure establishment of a competitive price and for awarding contracts 16 to the lowest responsible bidder. Such procedure shall require that a 17 good faith effort be made to request quotations from all contractors on the small works roster who have indicated the capability of performing 18 19 the kind of public works being contracted. Immediately after an award 20 is made, the bid quotations obtained shall be recorded, open to public inspection, and available by telephone inquiry. The small works roster 21 22 shall be revised at least once each year by publishing notice of such 23 opportunity in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the 24 district. Responsible contractors shall be added to the list at any 25 time they submit a written request. Whenever the estimated cost of a 26 public works project is ((twenty)) fifty thousand dollars or more, the 27 public bidding process provided in subsection (1) of this section shall be followed. 28
- 29 (4) The contract for the work or purchase shall be awarded to the 30 lowest responsible bidder as defined in RCW 43.19.1911 but the board 31 may by resolution reject any and all bids and make further calls for 32 bids in the same manner as the original call. On any work or purchase 33 the board shall provide bidding information to any qualified bidder or 34 the bidder's agent, requesting it in person.

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38 39 (5) In the event of any emergency when the public interest or property of the district would suffer material injury or damage by delay, upon resolution of the board declaring the existence of such an emergency and reciting the facts constituting the same, the board may waive the requirements of this section with reference to any purchase

- 2 section, means a condition likely to result in immediate physical
- 3 injury to persons or to property of the school district in the absence
