A community for which a community council is created may include 6 7 only unincorporated territory located in a single county with a population of over thirty thousand that is made up entirely of islands 8 and in counties with a population of over one million and not included 9 within a city or town. A community council must have at least one 10 thousand persons residing within the community when the community 11 council is created or, where the community only includes an entire 12 island, at least three hundred persons must reside on the island when 13 14 the community council is created. Any portion of such a community that is annexed by a city or town, or is incorporated as a city or town, 15 16 shall be removed from the community upon the effective date of the annexation or the official date of the incorporation." 17
