Ballot propositions shall conform 24 with RCW 84.52.054.
  - (2) The additional property tax levies may not be imposed until:
- 26 (a) The governing body of the county, city, or town declares the 27 existence of an emergency with respect to the availability of housing 28 that is affordable to very low-income households in the taxing 29 district; and
- (b) The governing body of the county, city, or town adopts an 30 affordable housing financing plan to serve as the plan for expenditure 31 32 of funds raised by a levy authorized under this section, and the governing body determines that the affordable housing financing plan is 33 34 consistent with either the locally adopted or state-adopted comprehensive housing affordability strategy, required under the 35
