- 17 (2) The director shall cause an investigation to be made following 18 the filing of a written complaint by an employee that alleges a 19 violation of this section. An order, conforming with the requirements 20 of RCW 51.52.050 and determining whether a violation has occurred, must 21 be issued within sixty days of the filing of the complaint.
- 22 (3) Employees of the department are immune from complaints under 23 this section for any acts or omissions while in the performance of 24 their duties.
- 25 **Sec. 2.** RCW 51.48.080 and 1985 c 347 s 7 are each amended to read 26 as follows:
- 27 Every person, firm, or corporation who violates or fails to obey,
- 28 observe, or comply with any <u>section of this title or any</u> rule of the
- 29 department ((promulgated)) <u>adopted</u> under authority of this title, shall
- 30 be subject to a penalty of not to exceed ((five hundred)) one thousand
- 31 dollars for each offense upon order of the director. In any complaint
- 32 filed by the worker or beneficiary alleging a violation of section 1 of
- 33 this act, the penalty shall accrue for the benefit of the worker or
- 34 beneficiary and shall be paid to the worker or beneficiary with the
- 35 benefits that may be assessed under this title.

- 1 Sec. 3. RCW 51.28.050 and 1984 c 159 s 1 are each amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 Except as provided in RCW 51.28.055, no application shall be valid 4 or claim thereunder enforceable unless filed within one year after the
- 5 day upon which the injury occurred or the rights of dependents or
- 6 beneficiaries accrued((, except as provided in RCW 51.28.055)).
- 7 However, if failure to file an application or take action to enforce an
- 8 otherwise enforceable claim within the one-year limit results from an
- 9 act prohibited under section 1 of this act, an application shall be
- 10 valid or claim under the application enforceable if filed within two
- 11 years after the day upon which the injury occurred or the rights of
- 12 <u>dependents or beneficiaries accrued.</u>"
