- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9.94A RCW 8 to read as follows:
- (1) Subject to the limitations of this section, any alien offender 9 10 committed to the custody of the department under the sentencing reform act of 1981, chapter 9.94A RCW, who has been found by the United States 11 12 attorney general to be subject to a final order of deportation or 13 exclusion, may be placed on conditional release status and released to 14 the immigration and naturalization service for deportation at any time 15 prior to the expiration of the offender's term of confinement. 16 Conditional release shall continue until the expiration of the 17 statutory maximum sentence provided by law for the crime or crimes of which the offender was convicted. If the offender has multiple current 18 convictions, the statutory maximum sentence allowed by law for each 19 20 crime shall run concurrently.
 - (2) No offender may be released under this section unless the secretary or the secretary's designee find that such release is in the best interests of the state of Washington. Further, releases under this section may occur only with the approval of the sentencing court and the prosecuting attorney of the county of conviction.
- 26 (3) No offender may be released under this section who is serving 27 a sentence for a violent offense or sex offense, as defined in RCW 28 9.94A.030, or any other offense that is a crime against a person.
- 29 (4) The unserved portion of the term of confinement of any offender 30 released under this section shall be tolled at the time the offender is 31 released to the immigration and naturalization service for deportation. 32 Upon the release of an offender to the immigration and naturalization
- 33 service, the department shall issue a warrant for the offender's arrest
- 34 within the United States. This warrant shall remain in effect until
- 35 the expiration of the offender's conditional release.

- 1 (5) Upon arrest of an offender, the department shall seek 2 extradition as necessary and the offender shall be returned to the 3 department for completion of the unserved portion of the offender's 4 term of total confinement. The offender shall also be required to 5 fully comply with all the terms and conditions of the sentence.
 - (6) Alien offenders released to the immigration and naturalization service for deportation under this section are not thereby relieved of their obligation to pay restitution or other legal financial obligations ordered by the sentencing court.
- 10 (7) Any offender released pursuant to this section who returns 11 illegally to the United States may not thereafter be released again 12 pursuant to this section.
- 13 (8) The secretary is authorized to take all reasonable actions to 14 implement this section and shall assist federal authorities in 15 prosecuting alien offenders who may illegally reenter the United States 16 and enter the state of Washington."
